Consider the Date of August 13, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. for a Public Hearing to Receive and Consider Comments on Eligible Judgment Levies – CFO Hill

There is currently just over \$36,000 in judgement levies available to capture if the Board wishes to hold a public hearing. The impact equates to approximately .26 per resident within the service area. Council Member Stewart abstained from discussion due to Riverton's current position. No Board Members were interested in pursuing the levies.

<u>Funding Station Construction/Pause to Evaluate Costs</u> – AC Burchett

AC Burchett recently took responsibility for Support Services and began reviewing the cost for stations to make sure he was ready for the construction. The previous work was focused on the actual construction without knowing the final location for a few facilities. Planning was centered around the implementation of the Darkhorse Software to help determine sites then finalize the numbers by January of 2021. With the push to begin sooner due to the existing bond rate, AC Burchett expressed discomfort of the finalizing of the total cost in preparation for securing the loan. Land for two stations in Eagle Mountain and the COVID delay for Darkhorse Software implementation created a need to reevaluate the costs and station location decisions.

AC Burchett is requesting providing a few months to get the Darkhorse Software on line and finalize the costs related to temporary facilities, site preparation, demolition, etc... so he can bring the Board more accurate numbers to meet the project needs. In addition, he is requesting the immediate hire of a project manager to help accurately define the costs and lead the UFSA through the entire construction project once funded.

Board Members expressed appreciation with AC Burchett's caution and feel that a project manager would best serve the projects and UFSA interests as well. Due to the low bond rates, it was urged to move the decisions forward quickly.

Chief Petersen noted that the January time frame was the original timeline intent, but due to the bond rates, this was moved forward considerably. The issues outlined by AC Burchett along with an

evaluation by Herriman to determine if it is best for them to stay with the UFSA or become a direct member are critical to allow for a little more time

Council Member Henderson stated that Herriman is conducting significant financial analysis and appreciates the pause to allow time to complete their work. Chief Petersen pointed out that there are two stations that are part of this build in Herriman. If these are not UFSA responsibility it would change the funding needs significantly. Council Member Henderson emphasized that this was a financial review for the city, they are not leaving the UFA, just determining if it is better to be a Direct Member or UFSA Member.

<u>Consideration of Hiring Project Management Services – AC Burchett/Division Chief Robinson</u>

Division Chief Robinson stated that there are three companies on state contract. Logistics has met with two of them and have decided to work with Construction Control for project management. The third company is a general contractor offering project management and staff is concerned about a conflict of interest. In 60-90 days, UFA will have an estimated cost for the stations.
