<u>Legislative Update</u>- Spencer Stokes, UFSA Lobbyist

Fireworks: Not really anyone opposed, but there will be changes. Chief Petersen has asked for support with no change in the bill, if opened for changes in the 2nd chamber; Chief Petersen will bring aerials back into the conversation.

- It is a committee bill, not a sponsored bill, so that should help
- Stokes will keep an eye on it

Entry/Exit for Special Districts: There are multiple pieces of legislation being presented

- Chief Petersen updated new board members about the Tier 1/Tier 2 distinction
- The State Auditor has been auditing departments across the state and becoming more of a player in policy
- The retirement will only affect fire/police, it won't bleed into any other discipline

- There is currently a proposal into the Benefit and Compensation Committee to help UFA enable their employees to "retire" when necessary
- This proposal must be looked at carefully so as to not create any unplanned consequences (unfunded liability issue)
- Stokes will stay on top of this legislation and keep Chief Petersen updated, updates will be sent out from UFA

UFSA Facilities Discussion- Assistant Chief Watson

Councilmember Stewart motioned to appoint Councilmember Perry as chair of Facilities Committee Councilmember Ferguson seconded Councilmember Perry accepted All in favor None opposed

 - a. Station tours will be scheduled for February for interested board members
 - b. Need: Identify stations that are sound in structure and those that need repair/replacement
 - c. Funds have been prioritized
 - d. Chief Petersen stated that the design of current stations isn't the best image for UFA/UFSA
 - e. The seismic review is primary and will dictate what will happen
 - Priorities 2018
 - 1. Seismic evaluation
 - 2. Architectural design
 - 3. Reroof Station 126
 - f. Cyndee Young will send out an email with potential tour dates

Quarterly Report- CFO Hill

Fiscal year is different than UFA

- No final report, the 2017 fiscal year just ended
- General Fund: bulk of the expenditures
- Revenues: exclusively funded by property taxes- coming in well
- Impact Fees: good year
- Expenses: the contract fee for UFA, most money goes for their service
- Capital lease: bond payment for 6 station rebuilds over the last 8-9 years
- Report can be provided quarterly since there are not a lot of expenses
- CFO Hill will bring the outstanding bond schedule to next meeting
